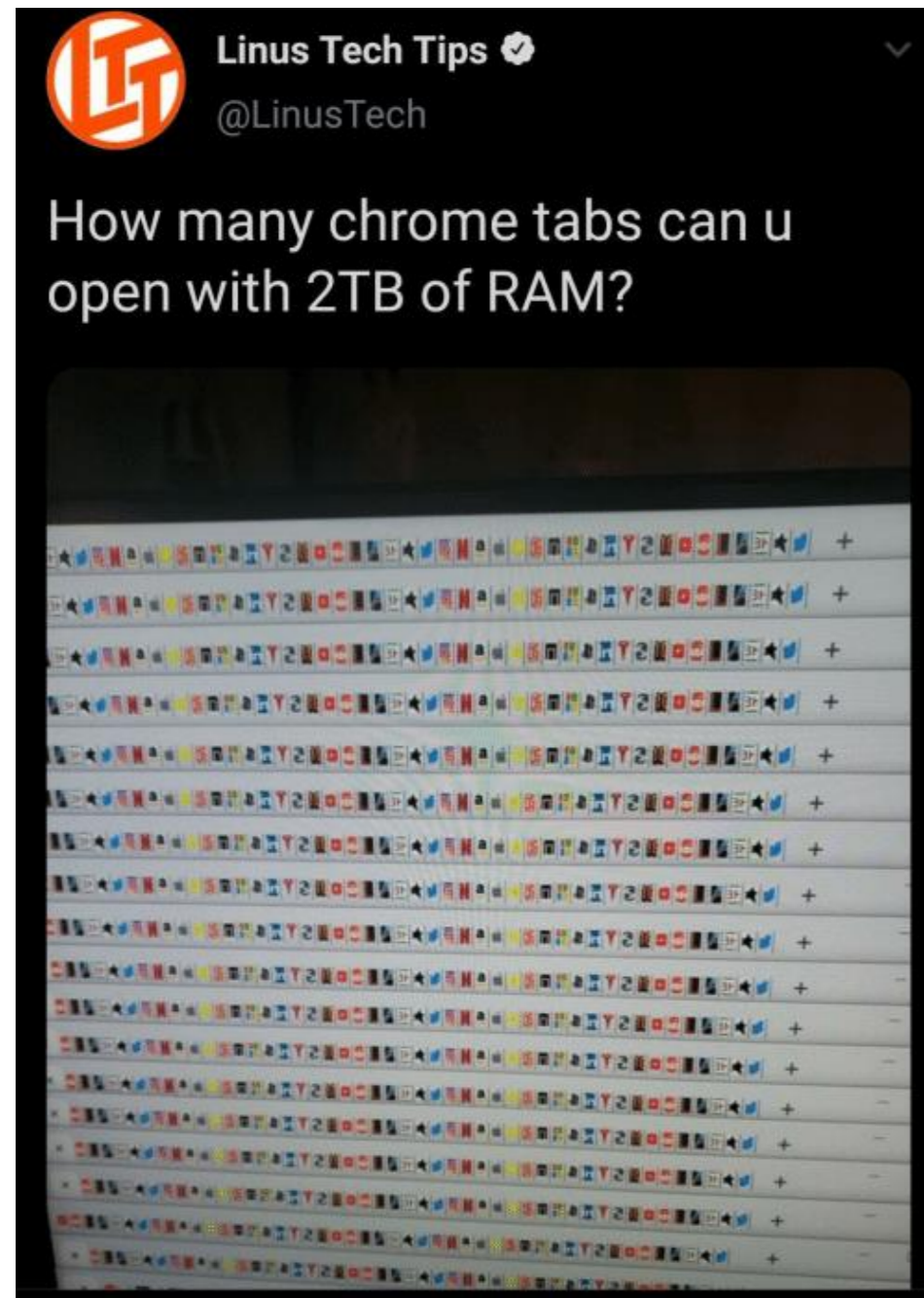

Browser Printing

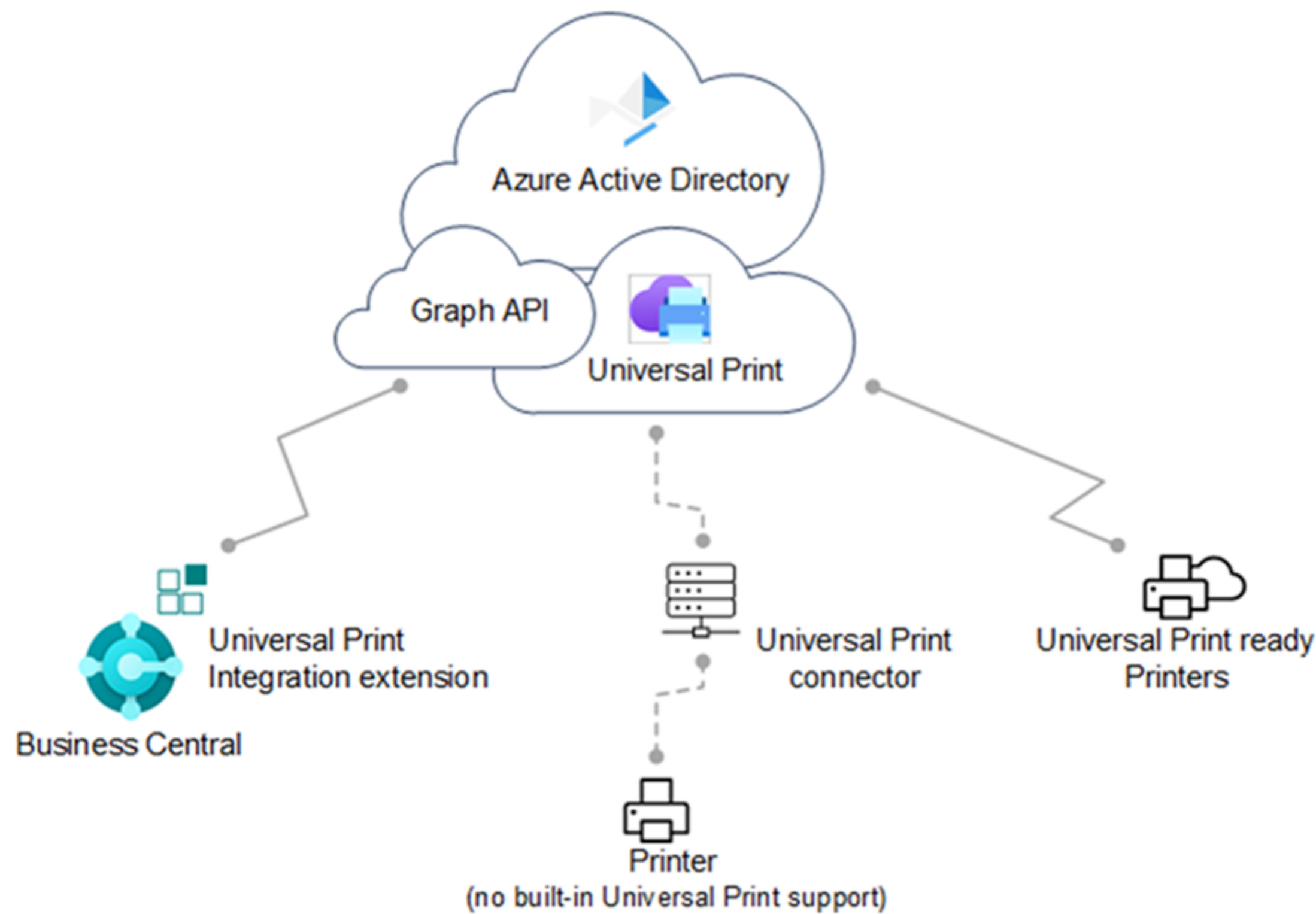


30,720 chrome tabs to my calculation

- Specific to the end user's workstation
- Can include any number of printing devices: universal print, cloud printing, network, local, etc.

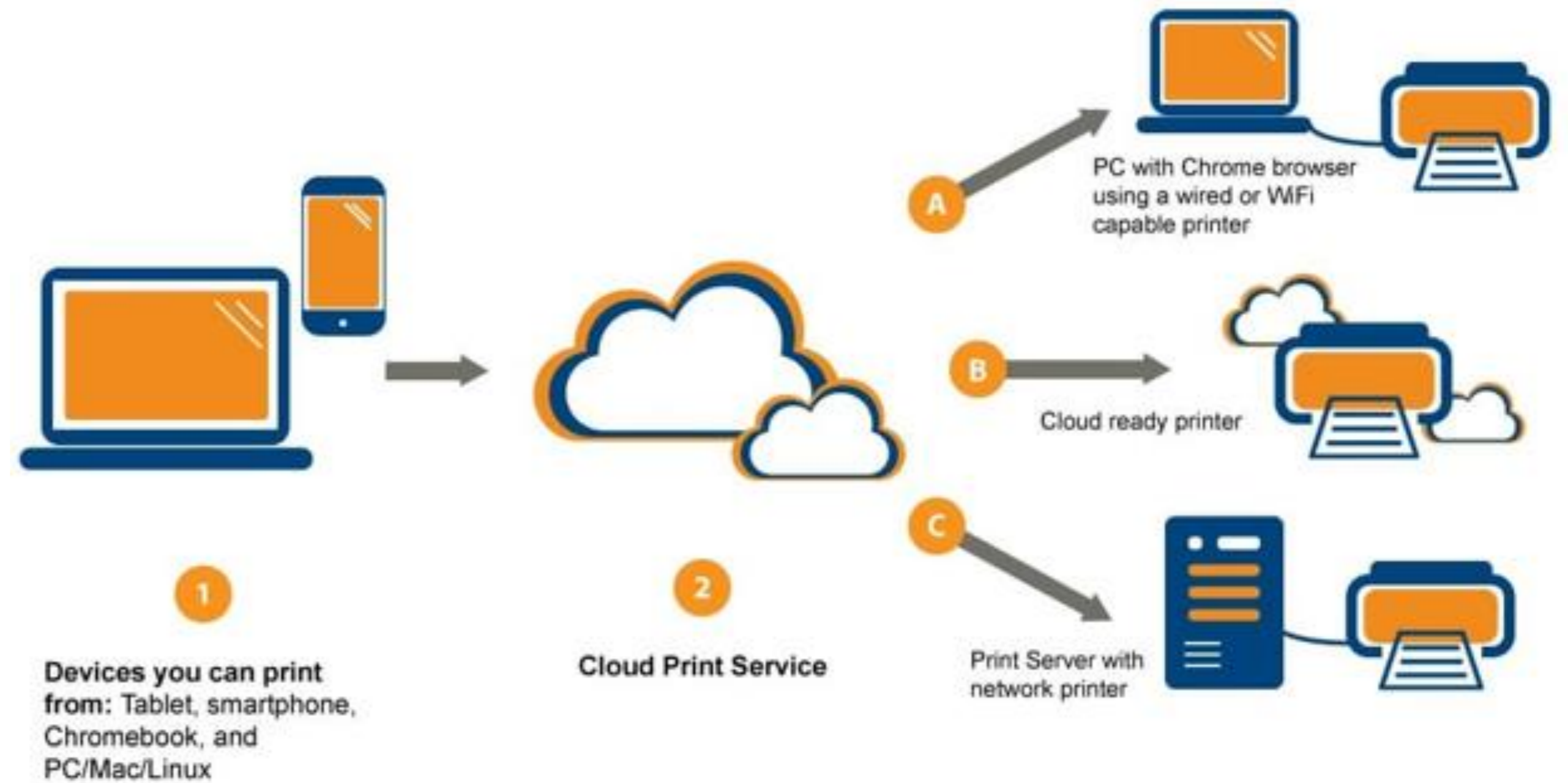
Universal Print

- Universal print ready printers work out of the box with little configuration
- Connectors run a small application to add support for unsupported printers



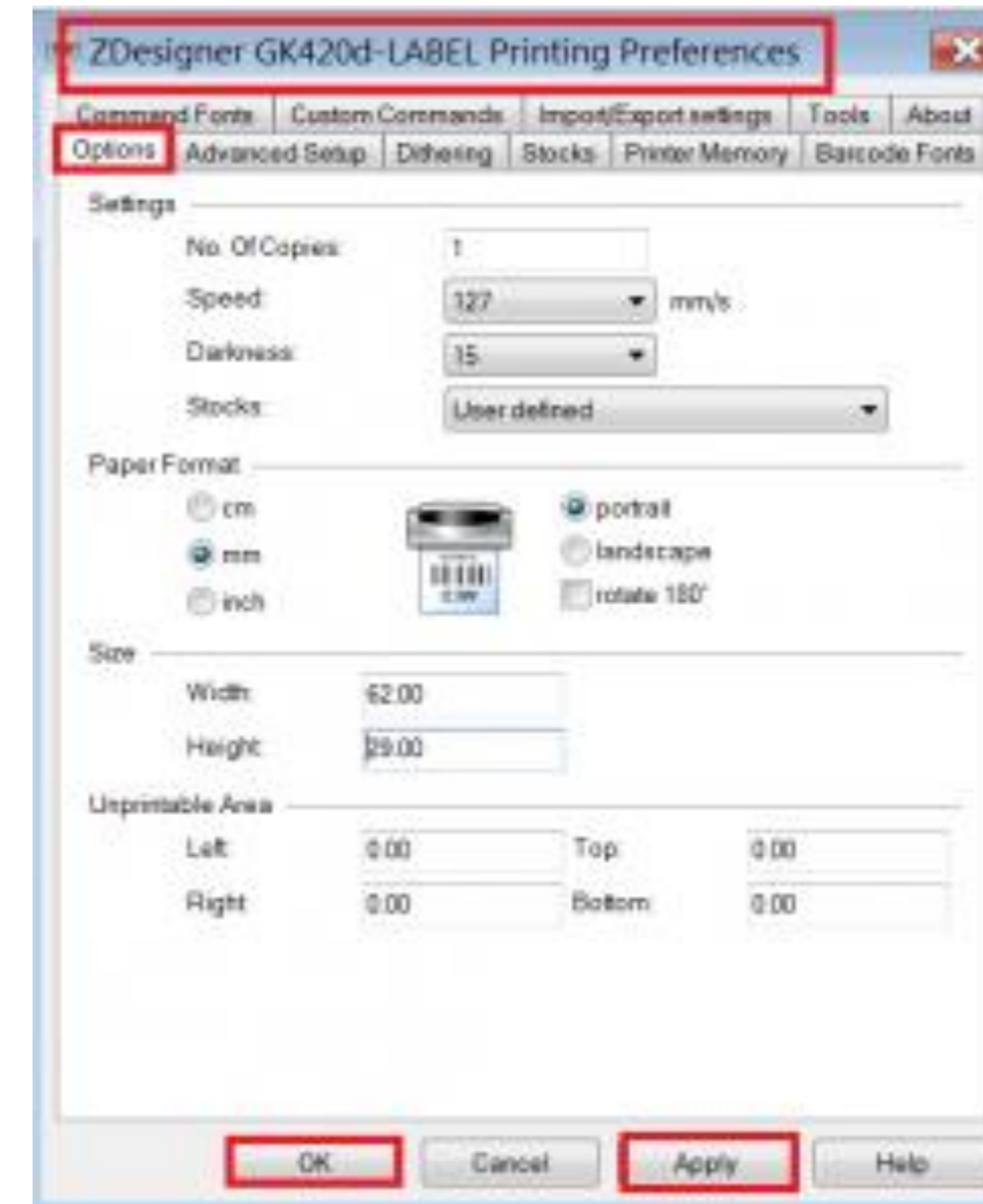
Cloud Printing Services

- BC App extensions
- Functionally very similar to Universal Print, but is vendor specific implementation



Label Printers

- Extension is more or less mandatory
- No planned support for Universal Print from Microsoft
