- ✓ Basic Requirements
- ✓ Nice to Have
- ✓ Optional Input
- ✓ Gotcha!
- ✓ GP to BC Comparisons
- ✓ Reporting



Basic Requirements

- Base UOM
 - Tip – set the base UOM as the smallest to avoid decimals
- Costing
- Posting Groups (Inventory, Product, Tax)
- Replenishment
 - Watch for dependencies based on how you replenish



Nice to Have

- Planning
 - Set policies, use the worksheets to create POs and RPOs
- Defaults
 - Setup pricing, costs, primary vendors
- References & Identifiers
 - Define customer/vendor part numbers, UPCs, etc. to allow lookups by those numbers AND scanning from vendor barcodes
- Scrap & Lot Sizes

Optional (In most cases)

- Variants
 - Great way to keep your item list shorter
 - Is the variant required on the part?
- Attributes
 - Define details about a product & use CoPilot to create marketing text
- Substitutes
 - Do you constantly run short and swap products?
- Warehousing (Start basic)
 - Implement barcoding and warehousing for streamlined processes
 - Utilize bins to organize inventory

Gotchas!

- Item Tracking
 - Inbound vs. Outbound – “specific tracking”
- UOM Translations
- Stockkeeping Units (SKUs)
 - Necessary for planning when multiple locations exist
- Over pick (IW) & Over receive
 - Think about rules to “control” inventory oops
